For use only if you were not required to submit a photo with your registration.

Please note: If you registered directly with ACT and were required to submit a photo, you CANNOT USE THIS ID LETTER in place of photo ID on test day. Instead you must bring an acceptable photo ID in accordance with ACT's security policy. See www.actstudent.org/faq/id.html for more information.

Required Identification

Before being admitted to test on test day, you are required to present both: **Your printed ACT admission ticket AND acceptable identification**. If you fail to bring your required identification you will not be allowed to test. If you have not received your ticket or you need to request a duplicate ticket, contact ACT by the Friday prior to test day to request a duplicate ticket (319.337.1270, 8 a.m. – 8 p.m. CT)
