## **Important Information**

## **New Procedure:**

Students are responsible to be working towards school 25.5 hours per week. This is newly being required to have documented with student work logs. We have had each student create Learning Plans which drive the credits needed as well as the courses needed. The goal of each student is to earn at least 5 credits per school year. Those that are already behind in credits will have to complete more than 5 in order to catch up.

#### **Attendance Policy**

- 1) Work on-site weekly for 2-3 hours minimum
- 2) Turn in COMPLETED Work 2-3 Exams/Units Every Week
- 3) K-8 students-all assigned work is to be completed weekly
