Through The Electrical Trades Center/Columbus State Community College's College Credit Plus Initiative a secondary student can simultaneously earn high school credits, college credits, apprenticeship credits, as well as an Ohio approved Industry Credential for graduation. The courses through the College Credit Plus Initiative are free to the student, which means no cost for tuition, books or fees if you attend.

- Earn high school credits toward graduation.
- Earn Columbus State Community College credits.
- Earn Electrical Trades Center credit toward completion of the electrical apprenticeship.
- Earn an Ohio Department of Education Approved Industry Credential

The Electrical Trades Center Electrical Apprenticeship to career pathway

- Successful College Credit Plus students start in the second year of apprenticeship.
- Apprentices are tuition free scholarship students.
- Accrue no college debt.
- Free Associates Degree from Columbus State Community College.
- Apprentices are employed from day one.
- Starting at \$27K plus paid health insurance and retirement
- Apprentice completers base wage is \$68K plus paid health insurance and retirement
