Keith participated in Wrestling during his time at HTHS, and although he was only here for his Junior and Senior years, what an impact he had. His HTHS record stands at 80 wins and 0 losses including winning his second State Title during his Senior season. He went on to the prestigious National Wrestling Coaches Association and competed in the Senior National Championships. After defeating multiple State Champions and one 4-time state champion from Florida, he finished as a national runner-up after a close one-point decision in the finals. Keith went on to win an NAIA National Title for Cumberland College, becoming their first National Champion in their school history.

Keith is survived by his sister, Katheryne Cupp and his children, Jackson Ray & Lennon Madison Cupp who will be accepting this honor on his behalf.
