The table below shows all the tax rates for the public school districts in Franklin County. The districts are listed in the order of highest total real estate tax rate to lowest. The tax rate for each district is broken down by each type of levy. General fund is the general operating fund of the districts' and accounts for the majority of operations in each district. Bond retirement fund is the millage necessary to retire debt that each district has issued. Permanent Improvement fund levies fund expenditures for larger, long lasting assets. This could be bus purchases, buildings, paving projects, or roof projects for example.
